### Program Requirements

Students must complete all the core compulsory courses within the program structure over 3 years (or part-time equivalent). Each course is usually worth 15 credit points. A total of 360 credit points is compulsory to satisfy the program requirements of the Bachelor of Education Studies. Students will need to apply for a Working with Children Check (WWCC) card before commencing their program. A copy of the WWCC card must be supplied to the University prior to commencing professional experience placements. ## Glossary

<b>Co-requisite (CoR):</b>	A course or courses that must be completed concurrently with the chosen course
<b>Pre-requisite (PR):</b>	A course or courses that must be completed prior to undertaking another course
<b>Exclusion(s)(EX):</b>	A course that is the equivalent to another course & so excludes students from repeating an equivalent course
<b>CR:</b>	Credit Point value
<b>Introductory:</b>	Courses that are coded 1000 – 1999, introductory-level courses
<b>Intermediate:</b>	Courses that are coded 2000 – 2999, intermediate-level courses
<b>Advanced:</b>	Courses that are coded 3000 – 3999, intermediate-level courses
<b>Major/Minor:</b>	The main subject area of study completed as part of a degree
<b>Semester:</b>	Designated teaching period
