## Glossary

Co-requisite (CoR): A course or courses that must be completed concurrently with the chosen course
Pre-requisite (PR): A course or courses that must be completed prior to undertaking another course
Exclusion(s)(EX): A course that is the equivalent to another course \& so excludes students from repeating an equivalent course

Introductory: Courses that are coded 1000-1999, introductory-level courses
Intermediate: Courses that are coded 2000-2999, intermediate-level courses
Advanced: $\quad$ Courses that are coded 3000 - 3999, intermediate-level courses
Major/Minor: $\quad$ The main subject area of study completed as part of a degree
Semester: Designated teaching period
